

General Packing List

- Play clothes (shorts and long pants)
- Sturdy tennis shoes
- Backpack
- Light jacket and rain gear
- Swimsuit, swim shoes, sunscreen (one piece for girls and boxer-style trunks for boys)
- Bedding for a twin bed (sleeping bag and/or sheets, blanket, pillow, and pillowcases)
- Towels, washcloth, soap, shampoo, etc.
- Duffel bag or pillowcase for dirty clothes.
- Flashlight with extra batteries (please label flashlights)
- Insect and/or tick repellent
- Water bottle
- Stationery and stamps (if you plan on sending letters)
- Small notebook, pen/pencil, and Bible
- Prescription medicine in original prescription bottle with camper name as patient name to be handed to staff at check-in. (We will only administer medication following the printed prescription directions.)
- Musical instrument, dance music, or other items for talent show (optional)
- Spending money (optional). Canteen food items (items range from \$.25 to \$3.00). Other items (T-shirts, bags, pencils, pens etc.) may be purchased ranging in cost from \$1.00 to \$15.00 each

Items NOT to bring:

- CELL PHONES or BEEPERS
- Razor scooters or skateboards
- Radios, CDs, or tape players
- Candy or gum
- Electronic games
- Basic first aid supplies (we stock most basic first aid supplies)
- Weapons such as guns or knives of any type (even camping knives)
- Alcohol, tobacco products, illegal drugs, or intoxicants
- Fireworks of any type
- Matches or lighters
- Valuable jewelry or keepsakes
